For the current quarter ended 30 September 2018, the Group recorded revenue of RM4.96 million, lower as compared to RM6.19 million in the corresponding quarter in previous year. This was mainly due to lower revenue from Electronic Payment segment but cushioned by new revenue from GEM segment. The gross profit margin for current quarter of 20% were lower than 68% in corresponding quarter in previous year, as a result of higher implementation cost arising from expansion of scope of work in software customization.

The Group recorded a loss before taxation for the current quarter of RM0.74 million, higher loss compared to profit before tax of RM1.34 million in the corresponding quarter in previous year mainly due to lower gross profit margin and share compensation expenses of RM0.84 million for the offering of share options to eligible employees, cushioned by unrealized forex gain of RM1.15 million as USD strengthen against Ringgit Malaysia.

The Proposed Share Issuance has been approved by the shareholders at the Extraordinary General Meeting held on 24 August 2017.

The Shares Issuance was completed on 19 January 2018. The 500 million Subscription Shares under the Share Issuance have fully subscribed by Macquarie Bank raising RM21,103,000.00 for the Company.
