For the current quarter ended 31 December 2018, the Group recorded revenue of RM4.08 million, consistent with corresponding quarter in previous year of RM4.19 million. The revenue were generated from Electronic Payment segment and GEM segment. The gross profit margin for current quarter of 16% were lower than 66% in corresponding quarter in previous year, as a result of higher implementation cost arising from expansion of scope of work in software customization in order to compete in current market.

The Group recorded a loss before taxation for the current quarter of RM6.79 million, higher loss compared to loss before tax of RM2.14 million in the corresponding quarter in previous year mainly due to lower gross profit margin and higher marketing expenses for promoting GEM products.

For the 6 months ended 31 December 2018, the Group recorded revenue of RM9.04 million, slightly lower compared to RM10.38 million in preceding year-todate, mainly due to lower revenue from Electronic Payment segment but cushioned by new revenue from GEM segment. The gross profit margin of 18% for current year was lower than preceding year-todate of 67% due to higher implementation cost arising from expansion of scope of work in software customization in order to compete in current market.

The group recorded a loss before tax of 7.53 million for the current year-todate, higher as compare with preceding year to-date loss of RM0.80 million mainly due to lower gross profit margin and higher marketing expenses for promoting GEM products, cushioned by unrealized forex gain of RM1.02 million as USD strengthen against Ringgit Malaysia.

For the current quarter ended 31 December 2018, Electronic payment services segment reported revenue of RM2.51 million and gross profit margin of 13%, lower than RM4.19 million revenue and gross profit margin of 65% in the corresponding quarter in previous year, was mainly due to lower sales of electronic payment solutions to overseas and higher implementation cost arising from expansion of scope of work in software customization in order to compete in current market.

The segment reported loss before tax of RM0.31 million in current quarter, lower than profit before tax of RM2.14 million in corresponding quarter in previous year mainly due to lower gross profit margin.

This segment achieved revenue of RM5.14 million, lower as compared with preceding year to-date of RM9.46 million due to lower sales of electronic payment solutions to oversea. The gross profit margin of 14% in current year to-date was lower than 73% in preceding year to-date mainly due to higher implementation cost arising from expansion of scope of work in software customization in order to compete in current market.

This segment recorded loss before tax of RM0.17 million, lower as compared with preceding year todate's profit before tax of RM5.88 million mainly due to lower revenue and lower gross profit margin.

The loss before tax of RM6.79 million in current quarter, higher as compared to RM0.74 million in previous quarter mainly due to higher marketing cost for promoting GEM products.

B3 FUTURE PROSPECTS

The Group is currently developing the MPex system together with third party developers, which the Group intends to offer the MPex system to its existing merchants which were previously obtained through its EFTPOS terminals business as well as secure new merchants.

Further to the above, the Group intends to leverage on its existing experience, technologies and infrastructures in the mobile payment segment to venture into the mobile app space via the development of GEM app, which is expected to enhance the income stream of the Group.

The Group will continue to pursue business ventures domestically and internationally to propel future growth. Despite the uncertain market condition, the Group is optimistic to deliver a reasonable performance for the financial year ending 30 June 2019.
